- What led people in the time of Christ to believe in him?
- What led people in the early days of Christianity (the days of intense persecution) to believe in him?
- What leads people to believe in him today, 21 centuries later?
- What difference has/does believing in him made in people's lives?
- Do you believe in him?
Why or why not?



How are we going to try to answer these questions?

- Over the next week we are going to watch the 1951 epic film “Quo Vadis” (Where are you going?)
- The film is based on an 1895 novel that took information and stories (like the Acts of Peter) about the first few decades of Christianity to tell a story about people’s faith – people who knew Jesus, like Peter and Paul, and people who, like us, didn’t know Jesus in a historical sense, like the Roman Christians.



How are we going to try to answer these questions?

- As we watch, your job will be to think about the questions:
 - What led people in the time of Christ to believe him?
 - What led people in the early days of Christianity to believe in him?
 - What leads people to believe in him today, 21 centuries later?
 - What difference has/does believing in him made in people's lives?
 - Do you believe in him? Why or why not?
- After we finish the film, it will be your job to write a three (or more) page paper that answers these five questions.
